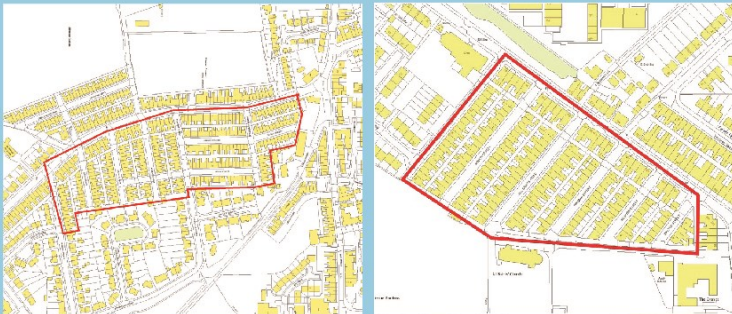


What is a Time Limited Project?

A time limited project (TLP) is a multi-agency response to particular issues affecting a community. Partners work together over a specified period of time to achieve its aims.

The Safe Durham Partnership is a multi-agency body, including Durham County Council, Schildon Town Council and Durham Constabulary. The Partnership shares information and works together to reduce crime, fear of crime and tackle anti-social behaviour (ASB).

This project is concentrated in the Byerley and Redworth Road areas of Schildon over a period of 6 months from the 1st April to 30th September 2018.
