SA 24/15 Hackworth Park CCTV

The Town Clerk updated Members on the installation of the upgraded CCTV system in Hackworth Park, Shildon. Following a survey by Baydale Control Systems it was identified that the proposed configuration was unable to view the skatepark area due to the sightline being impeded by mature trees and therefore a cost was obtained to provide an additional column and camera within the skate park/larger play area to provide the additional coverage. A revised capital cost had been submitted by Baydale Control Systems along with revised monitoring costs provided by Durham County Council for the new configuration which resulted in reduced capital cost to the Town Council due to connectivity costs being lower and certain groundworks being carried out by the Direct Workforce. In order to ensure that the revised camera configuration was in place before the refurbishment of the skate park was completed the Town Clerk had given prior agreement to the implementation of the revised configuration.
